Changes and late entries:	up to 2 hours before the start of the test for double the entry fee. Late entries must be made by the national team managers.

Arrival:	possible from Monday, 1st August 2022, 12:00 o'clock		
Vaccination:	Horses must be vaccinated according to IPO (German Rules and Regulation for Icelandic horse events) and have at least 2 vaccinations, the same applies to imported horses. All horses must come from a healthy stock. The equine passport must be presented at the registration office. There is no compulsory herpes vaccination.		
Doping controls:	In addition to the FEIF Rules and Regulations, the regulations of the IPO A I National Regulations also apply to the event. According to § 12.3 IPO A I the IPZV e.V. follows the FN Anti-Doping and Medication Control Rules for Equestrian Sport - ADMR - and the lists of prohibited substances and prohibited methods in the respective valid versions.		
Liability:	Participation in the event and the accommodation of the horses is at your own risk. Riders and horse owners are liable without limitation according to § 833 BGB. For each participating horse there must be an animal liability insurance in place for the duration of the event. During the entire event the rider/owner remains animal custodian according to § 834 BGB. Riders and horse owners must ensure that appropriate supervision and care of the participating horses in accordance with Art. 4.2 "Guidelines for the Use of Horses from an Animal Welfare Point of View" are guaranteed during the event. This includes, among other things, a secure fence, a sufficiently large area for lying down and feeding, and suitable protection from the weather. The organizer, show director and chief judge are excluded from any liability as far as legally permissible.

Special regulations:

Implementation according to FEIF Rules and Regulations / IPO (German Rules and Regulations)

All tests will be held in 2 age groups:

Young riders (16 - 21 years | born 2005 - 2000) and adults (22 years | born 1999 or older)

The championship titles will be awarded in both age groups in the T1, T2, V1, F1, P1, P2, and PP1 tests as well as in the overall four- and five-gait classes.

Tests with MEM titles: Depending on the number of starters, the preliminaries will be held together or separately according to age groups. The finals will be ridden and scored separately.

Tests without MEM title: The preliminaries will be ridden together. Depending on the number of starters, the finals will be ridden and scored together or separately according to age groups.

The Nations Ranking will be determined by the highest total scores of the three best rider-horse combination per test group (Preliminary scores). The test groups are:

PP1	T1 / T3	V1 / V2
P1 / P2	T2 / T4	F1 / F2

Qualification for participation at MEM2022 is subject to national regulations.

Other:

CORONA RESTRICTIONS:

The event will be held according to the specifications of the organizer under the then valid Corona regulations and the hygiene concept approved by the District Health Office. The regulations to be observed will be published immediately before the event on the website of the organizer (www.mem2022.eu) and the German Federal Association (www.ipzv.de). The participants and accompanying persons undertake to comply with these regulations by handing in their entry form and by entering the event area.
